- 1. The Red Fort Selection Sauvignon Blanc** £14.95
Fresh and lively nectarine and passion fruit flavours layered with refreshing green herbal characters and a squeaky clean zippy finish.
- 2. Piesporter Michelsberg – Germany** £13.95
A light, floral Mosel - medium in taste with fresh, tangy fruit flavours.
- 3. Paarl Heights Chenin Blanc – South Africa** £13.95
Easily the Cape's most popular wine style, with crisp green apple fruit flavours, fresh floral aromatics and a soft, clean finish.
- 4. Sierra Grande Sauvignon Blanc – Chile** £14.95
Fine and focused with fresh grassy aromas leading to an aromatic depth of concentrated gooseberry and passion fruit.
- 5. Soldiers Block Chardonnay – Australia** £15.95
Complex Chardonnay displaying nuts and cinnamon spice on the nose. Flavours of melon, peach and butterscotch linger on the wonderful creamy texture.
- 6. Pinot Grigio Conviviale – Italy** £15.95
The highly fashionable Pinot Grigios of northern Italy continue to impress. Very clean, dry and fragrant with a crisp honeyed finish.
- 7. Artesa Rioja Viura - Spain** £16.95
A really elegant, interesting glass of wine. Lovely floral aromatics and mouth-filling, lightly spicy quality.
- 8. Chablis Jean Moreau – France** £19.95
Crisp, clean and focused, this is modern forward style Chablis with a crunch of acidity behind a core of soft fruit, pure and racy.

Champagnes

- 9. Stephane Breton Brut N.V. – France** £29.95
A small grower from the south of the Champagne region, Breton produces a deliciously fresh, buttery N.V. with soft, creamy mousse.
- 10. Moet Et Chandon Brut N.V. – France** £39.95
The house of Moet produces one of the finest N.V.s. A well aged, full-bodied style with complex, toasty, honeyed notes.

Red Wines

- 11. The Red Fort Selection Merlot** £14.95
A soft full-bodied Merlot, rich in ripe berry fruit character. Plum and vanilla palate flavour and velvety mouth feel-very easy drinking.
- 12. Andes Peaks Merlot – Chile** £15.95
Fragrant aromas of fresh strawberry, plum and vanilla complemented by a hint of dried herbs. Sweetly fruited, well rounded, irresistibly easy drinking.
- 13. Chianti Colli Senesi Panezio – Italy** £15.95
Classic Italian wine, with herby rich cherry notes and fresh acidity.
- 14. False Bay Pinotage – South Africa** £16.95
Dense, powerful mulberry and blackberry fruit. Careful oak ageing unlocks the unique Pinotage flavour to its full potential.
- 15. Murphy's Shiraz – Australia** £17.95
Mouth filling blackberry fruit dominates this deliciously soft, subtle textured Shiraz with typically vibrant pepper and spice on the finish.
- 16. Urban U.C.O. Malbec - Argentina** £17.95
Multiple layers of volumptuous blackberry fruit merge with enticing, nutty aromas and delicious mocha flavours to create a memorable Malbec.
- 17. Puerta Vieja Crianza Rioja – Spain** £19.95
Pronounced aromas of dried fruits along with spicy notes from the new wood. A robust, fruity Crianza with soft tannins and balanced finish.
- 18. Chateauneuf-du-Pape Chemin Des Papes – France** £24.95
Intense red fruit aromas with hints of fresh spices, ripe fleshy black fruits with cocoa beans and caramel - a classic Chateauneuf-du-Pape.

- 19. Mateus Rose** £14.95
Ever popular medium dry pink wine with a faint spritz and soft strawberry tones.
- 20. Beringer Stone Cellars Zinfandel Rose – USA** £16.95
Smooth, well balanced, with soft aromas. Flavours of fresh strawberries and a crisp medium to dry finish.
